# A Guide for Employers

Case study template guidance



#### Introduction

This guidance document outlines how to create case studies using our PowerPoint case study template, and how to insert them into The Education Landscape: A Guide for Employers. This can be completed in four simple steps as shown below.


1. Choose your layout



**2.** Populate the template



**3.** Export to pdf



**4.** Insert into Guide



In order to complete this process you will need a PDF editing application such as Adobe Acrobat.

### Case study layouts

There are three layouts to choose from. Use whichever one suits your needs best.



Single case study: 1 column text 80–200 words / large image

Single case study: 2 column text 300–400 words / large image

**Double case study** 150–200 words / small image

# Populating the template

Below are a few pointers to note when populating the template in PowerPoint.

To format the text in the different styles click on the 'Increase/Decrease' List Level.



Add your case study — image here. This would ideally feature your workplace to give context to the case study copy.

Case study copy can range between 80–300 words depending on the template selected.


Update name, job title, company name and county/area.

Keep pull quotes short and snappy. If more room is needed for case study copy, the pull quote can be deleted.

# Populating the template

This template layout has been designed to ensure that your case study can be easily inserted into the Guide and that all elements remain consistent throughout. We recommend that you use the template in its original form.

However, if you are working with a design specialist and need to adjust the layout, use the gridlines function to keep elements aligned and orderly. To do this, click the 'View' tab and the check the 'Gridlines' box.



If moving text boxes, keep the case study text and the pull-out quote aligned on the right-hand side. They will not be fully aligned on the left-hand side, so the left quote marks should hang outside the alignment.

# Populating the template

Once you've populated the layout that best suits your needs, delete any unused slides from your file.

# Exporting and inserting

Once you have updated the template and finalised the design of your case study, the next step is to export the PowerPoint file in the correct file format. Outlined below is a step-by-step guide to exporting your file as a PDF and how to insert it into the master 'Education Landscape – Guide for Employers' PDF.

## 1. Exporting to PDF (PC)

- Select 'File > Export'
- Click 'Create PDF/XPS Document', then click 'Create PDF/XPS.'
- In the 'Publish as PDF or XPS dialog box', choose a location to save the file to.
  If you want it to have a different name, enter it in the File name box.

#### Exporting to PDF (macOS)

There are two ways to make your PowerPoint for macOS presentation a PDF.

1. You can save your presentation as a PDF in 'File > Save As'.

or

2. You can export your presentation as a PDF file by going to File > Export.

Method 1: Save your presentation as a PDF

- Select 'File > Save As.'
- Choose the location where you'd like to save your PDF, and then in the File Format menu, choose PDF.

Method 2: Export your presentation as a PDF

- Select 'File > Export.'
- In the File Format menu, choose PDF.

### 2. Inserting your case study PDF


 Open the master 'Education Landscape – Guide for Employers' PDF in the application 'Adobe Acrobat' or another PDF editing application of your choice.



In the page thumbnails go to the case study section and decide where you'd like to insert your case study.



3. Add your case study PDF by right-clicking on the page, selecting 'Insert pages,' and then 'From file...'




 Drag and drop the page thumbnails to change the order of your inserted pages if they're not in the correct position within the document.

#### Front cover

An alternative cover is available as an editable PDF document should you wish to add your company logo.

To add/replace the cover to the master 'Education Landscape – Guide for Employers' PDF, follow the inserting pages into PDF guidance outlined on the previous page in these guidelines.
